

Syllabus changes for the Spring 2022 Group and Health FSA Exams:

Specialty – There were several changes made to the Specialty syllabus for the Spring 2022 exam, and they are discussed below.

Four study notes were added:

- GHS-127-22: The Risks of Pricing New Insurance Products: The Case of Long Term Care
 - *This paper used to be on the syllabus in the past. It is nice example of the struggles any new type of insurance can face. Putting a price on uncertainty is difficult!*
- GHS-131-22: ERM – Health Risk Controls
 - *This paper is a really thorough outline of subfactor risk controls, specifically for a health insurer. It is helpful because it ties back to the other main ERM paper on the syllabus. The second half is an example of risk monitoring specifically for COVID experience.*
- GHS-132-22: COVID-19 ORSA Guide: Understanding Risk within the ‘New Normal’
 - *This paper is about all of the possible impacts that need to be considered for COVID. It addressed all types of different insurance products. These are all great examples of items that an insurer would want to incorporate into an ORSA.*
- Changing with the Times: The Past and the Future of ACA Risk Adjustment
 - *This paper is discussed all of the changes that the ACA risk adjustment process brought to the individual and small group commercial market. It focused on two main segments of differences: model changes and market changes.*

The following item was modified:

- GHS-130-22: Chapter 41 of Group Insurance, 8th Edition
 - *This replaces (and updates) chapter 39 from Skwire 7th ed.*

Finally, the following items were removed from the syllabus:

- GHS-123-18: Enterprise Risk Management: Parts One, Two and Three
- Risk Considerations for Innovative Products – A Case Study of the Long-Term Care Industry
