

# MATE Seminars Extension Policy



MATE Seminars wants you to pass your exams! We offer seminar attendees who need a second attempt a few options for using our study materials a second time.

We are offering customers extended digital access, into the next season, of the recorded seminar you attended. If there is a new virtual seminar in the next season I delete the old seminar, and will give access to the new seminar after it is recorded. If you attended an in-person seminar the digital extension applies as well, but reattending an in-person seminar is not part of this free extension. In-person seminar attendees will be allowed to have the digital access extension.

In either situation if you want the updated seminar materials reprinted and shipped to you, we ask that you pay \$50 to cover costs of materials, printing and shipping. If you are happy to use all digital content, then you would not need to pay anything to have digital access to the next seminar. The seminar outline and practice problem set can only be viewed in a browser window. All other seminar digital content is downloadable.

For the Outline / Lists / Note cards / ANKI material, we treat that differently than the seminar. If you want the updated versions of that material you will need to purchase that separately.

If your employer does not reimburse you for exam materials, we do offer a self-pay discount, which can be applied to the new materials purchased.

If the SOA restructures or renames an exam, we may be able to offer access to some or all of the new exam's seminar and materials for your second attendance.

# MATE Seminars Extension Policy



Below is an **illustrative example** of how the policy would actually work:

If you attend the in-person DP seminar in the spring of 2022

- ◆ You will have access to recorded digital content during the spring of 2022
- ◆ You will continue to have that access through the fall of 2022
  - ◇ If a new virtual seminar is recorded in the fall of 2022 then I will replace the springs seminar content with the updated fall content
  - ◇ If there is not a new virtual seminar for your exam in the fall you will have digital access to your spring content through the fall
- ◆ This extension does not allow you to reattend an in-person seminar in the fall at no cost. Repeating attendance in the fall to an in-person seminar would require repurchasing the seminar.

If you attended a virtual DP seminar in the spring of 2022

- ◆ You will have access to that recorded digital content during the spring of 2022
- ◆ You will continue to have that access through the fall of 2022
  - ◇ If a new virtual seminar is recorded in the fall of 2022 then I will replace the springs seminar content with the updated fall content
  - ◇ If there is not a virtual seminar for your exam in the fall you will have digital access to your spring content through the fall

If you can not sit for the fall exam this extension can be pushed into the spring 2023 season, but this must be requested before the beginning of the fall 2022 season. This allows people who only sit for exams one time per year to also take advantage of this extension.
